New laws coming for young drivers in 2014

The South Australian Parliament has passed new laws for young drivers, to come into effect in 2014. We will keep you informed about the changes through My Licence News and [facebook.com/mylicence](https://www.facebook.com/mylicence).

The new rules will include:

- A passenger restriction for P1 drivers under the age of 25, allowing no more than one passenger aged 16 to 20 years for the duration of their P1 licence, excluding immediate family members.
- A restriction on driving between midnight and 5am for P1 drivers under the age of 25 for the duration of their P1 licence.
- Extending the total minimum provisional licence period from two to three years. This will mean one year on a P1 licence and two years on a P2 licence.
- Removing regression to a previous licence stage following a disqualification period.
- The Hazard Perception Test (HPT) being a requirement of graduation from L to P1, rather than P1 to P2.

A series of [exemptions](#) will be available for passenger and night time driving.
