



PROVISIONAL LICENCE HOLDERS UNDER THE AGE OF 25 ARE NOT PERMITTED TO DRIVE A HIGH POWERED VEHICLE

Vehicles manufactured before 1 January 2010

A high powered vehicle is a light vehicle with a Gross Vehicle Mass of less than 4500kgs that has:

- eight or more cylinders
a turbocharged or supercharged engine (except diesel powered vehicles with less than 8 cylinders)
modifications to increase engine performance (other than a modification by the manufacturer in the course of the manufacture of the vehicle).
been nominated a high performance vehicle as listed in the South Australian Government Gazette, further information is available at mylicence.sa.gov.au

Vehicles manufactured on or after 1 January 2010

A high powered vehicle is a light vehicle with a Gross Vehicle Mass of less than 4500kgs that has:

- a power to weight ratio greater than 130 kilowatts per tonne in tare mass; or
modifications to engine performance (other than a modification by the manufacturer in the course of the manufacture of the vehicle).
